

> **TAP sells Lockheed to euroAtlantic**

TAP completed the sale of the Lockheed plane to euroAtlantic, PressTUR confirmed today with TAP and euroAtlantic, though both companies refused to reveal the value of the deal.

The Lockheed L-1011-500 Tristar was one of the recompenses from the sale of White to OMNI in 2006 which, on that occasion, bought the Airbus 310.

Contacted by PressTUR the chairman of euroAtlantic Airways, Tomás Metello, also confirmed the deal, refusing to disclose the amount, stating that they were “confidential figures”, but saying “that the purchase had already been announced some time ago, having been completed last Friday” (May 31st).

As regards the destination of the plane and in view of the current situation it is in, Tomás Metello mentioned that the main objective will be to serve as support to the Lockheed which is already in the service of euroAtlantic.

“The main objective will be to use the parts which may be needed and use them on the other plane”, he added.

The current fleet of euroAtlantic has a total of seven planes, all long-haul (a B757, five B767s and a L1011).
