



> **euroAtlantic strengthens fleet with the acquisition of another Boeing B767**

The Portuguese air company euroAtlantic strengthened its fleet of long-haul planes with the acquisition of a Boeing B767-300 ER, bringing to five the total aircraft of this model and its total long-haul aircraft to seven.



euroAtlantic indicated that with this acquisition "it has increased its assets by over" 59 million euros. The new plane, with two Pratt & Whitney series PW4060 engines and Etops 138 minutes autonomy, carries 215 passengers and was registered in Portugal under the registration CS-TLO. According to the company, the plane was acquired from Sunrok Aircraft Corporation (SAC), an aircraft leasing company based in George Town in Grand Cayman and was owned by SAC-24318 Ltd. from the British West Indies. In a communiqué the company chaired by Tomaz Metello, the founder and major shareholder - and in which the Pestana Group has already been authorised to take up a stake – also states that in the tourist trip segment "it has a controlling interest" of the Tourist Operator Sonhando S.A. which owns the brands terraBrasil and terraÁfrica terraEuropa, inter alia, and the Operator Turístico Atlantic Holidays in Spain and which since July 1st last year has been "in partnership" with the Pestana Group, "another of the subscribers to the Companhia Ibérica de Turismo Global - CITG, SGPS assumed the management of the Intervisa travel agents networks acquired further to authorisation by the Competition Authority".
